Jim Conditt began his career in public health in 1989 at the East Texas A.I.D.S. Project, now known as Health Horizons of East Texas, Inc., as an outreach worker to prevent transmission of H.I.V. and S.T.D. infections. Jim went on to become the Director of Prevention Services for HHET and served for eleven years before leaving HHET to attend Stephen F. Austin State University.

Jim attended SFASU for three years where he earned a Bachelor's of Applied Arts and Sciences with a double major in Social Work and Sociology. While at the university Jim was awarded the Jane Addams Award for Community Social Work, and graduated top of his college with Summa Cum Laude honors.

Upon graduation Jim was employed by the Texas AHEC East Program office to develop a statewide health professions workforce community development program, and assist with various special projects.

When the 81st Texas Legislature funded the physician and dentist loan repayment programs, and created the Children's Medicaid Loan Repayment Program, Jim was tapped to coordinate the project for the Texas Primary Care Office at the Texas Department of State Health Services.

After the 82nd Texas Legislature defaulted on the loan repayment programs, Jim moved to West Texas to serve as the Director of Data Management and Analytics for Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center, before returning home to Central Texas to serve as the Center Director for the Capital Region AHEC.
